How to care for your wood floor!

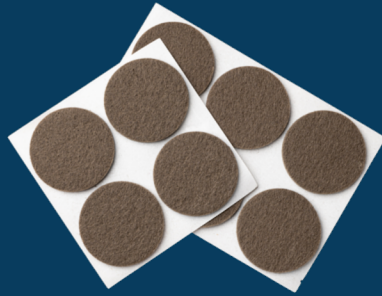


Whether you've recently had a new wood floor installed in your space or restored your existing one... this guide assists you in properly maintaining your wood floors. Follow these recommendations to ensure your floors remain in excellent condition for years to come, courtesy of Art of Clean.

Let's face it – it will get dirty!
Your cleaning regime is the only weapon
you have.

PLEASE NOTE

Do not place metal furniture in direct contact with a wet wood floor as this can cause marks or stains. Floor protectors is strongly advised.



Regularly remove dry soil:

To protect wood floors and their finish, it's crucial to regularly remove dry soil and grit, which can wear down the finish. Maintaining a soil-free floor can be achieved by using a high-quality soft broom or floor duster, such as the one provided in the Bona Premium Spray Mop. Alternatively, a vacuum cleaner equipped with a soft floor attachment is also effective in keeping your wood floors in pristine condition.

Entrance Mats:

Grit and dry soil brought in from outdoors can quickly damage your wood floors. To mitigate this, we recommend placing large, sturdy walk-off mats at all entry points of your home.

Additionally, the protection of your floors from furniture is essential. We highly recommend using felt pad protectors under all furniture pieces. These are not ordinary pads; they include replaceable pads that can be easily swapped out for new ones. Furthermore, these protectors are designed to screw in, ensuring greater durability and enhanced safety for your floors.

Cleaning Routine

For maintaining and cleaning oiled and lacquered wood floors, the Bona Premium Spray Mop and Bona cleaning solution are highly recommended.

Daily Clean:

Begin by dusting the floor with a suitable duster. Next, utilise the

- Bona Premium Spray Mop
- Microfiber pad

Apply the Bona cleaning solution using the mop's spray function and clean your wood floor. This method is ideal for daily upkeep or promptly addressing spills and marks.



Standard Clean:

Prepare your Bona cleaning solution as instructed. Moisten the mop with the solution and thoroughly wring it out. Clean approximately 3-5 square meters of the floor, then rinse and wring the mop.

Continue this process until the entire area is clean. Allow the floor to dry before resuming normal use. In large spaces, you may need to refresh the rinse water periodically.

Deep Clean:

For heavily soiled floors, a two-bucket cleaning system is advisable.

Immerse the mop in the Bona cleaning solution and wring it out thoroughly. After cleaning a section of about 3-5 square meters, rinse the mop in the second bucket filled with clean water. Ensure the mop is well rinsed before dipping it back into the cleaning solution. Continue this method for each section of the floor. Let the floor dry completely before returning to normal use.

For extensive areas, replace the rinse water as it becomes dirty.

Why Use a Two-Bucket Cleaning System?

Using a single bucket for heavily soiled floors can lead to dirt accumulation in your cleaning solution, spreading grime back onto the floor with each rinse. A two-bucket system keeps the cleaning solution cleaner, ensuring more effective cleaning.
